Re: South Wales Police Bullying

In 2009/10 I was incarcerated both in Cardiff and Caswell Clinic prisons for over 7 months.

I was eventually found not guilty, my having called no evidence.

The South Wales Police authority refuse to investigate my gathered witness statements, since my release from prison, of police having had a "shoot to kill" policy, to avoid the trial and when that failed, painting the prosecution exhibit, one WWI Lewis machine gun, a different colour to try and fool the jury!

All this was to, again, delay my ongoing civil action for 18 years of police bullying.

Are you now prepared to investigate any of this with the IPCC also refusing and giving the Police Authority 'dispensation', as they call it, to be investigated?
