Time is ticking by for sorting out serious outstanding matters as I still have no replies from:

- 1) Cardiff magistrate for release of 1st December 2011 court and custody records-
 - 2) Cardiff Crown Court for release of subsequent 1st March 12 appeal records, incl exhibits
 - 3) Cardiff Crown Court release of 3rd May 2012 jury trial records re above hearings
 - 4) Cardiff Magistrates reluctance to process my legal aid application submitted a year ago!
 - 5) Cardiff Magistrate reluctance to process six applications /appeals relating to CPS conduct
 - 6) current costs incurred should I withdraw the appeal due my current incarceration
 - 7) CPS re disclosure issues and outstanding from HHJ Andrea Jones QC's Court Order
 - 8) CPS release of depts. re above jury trials and Nov 2012 aborted one (2nd Breach of R/O)
 - 9) Your Court:
- i) incl. facilities now for interviewing CPS problem witnesses before I am moved to Bristol
 - ii) re my issuing a number of essential defence witness summonses in time for rebuttal
 - iii) re my Writ of Habeas Corpus Application
 - iv) re application for HMP Swansea to allow access to my legal data on my laptop and legal files allowed whilst in HMP Cardiff . Access to interview witnesses.....

This above list far from exhaustive

Today, I am typing on the this newly acquired 'Access to Justice' laptop issued only by court intervention after eleven months in custody with out one. Did your court intervene?

Rumour is that I might print off from laptop, later this month and after, after acquiring sufficient funds by 'inside trading', via access to my funds or those of helpers for the stationary requisite, you may receive this wee missive by Christmas but which Christmas I am not sure.

Meantime, please return my hand written letters to convert to legible, if not coherent ones, since June 12 conviction in Cardiff Magistrates as they may generally enhance 'due process' I hope.
