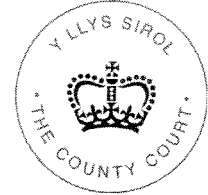

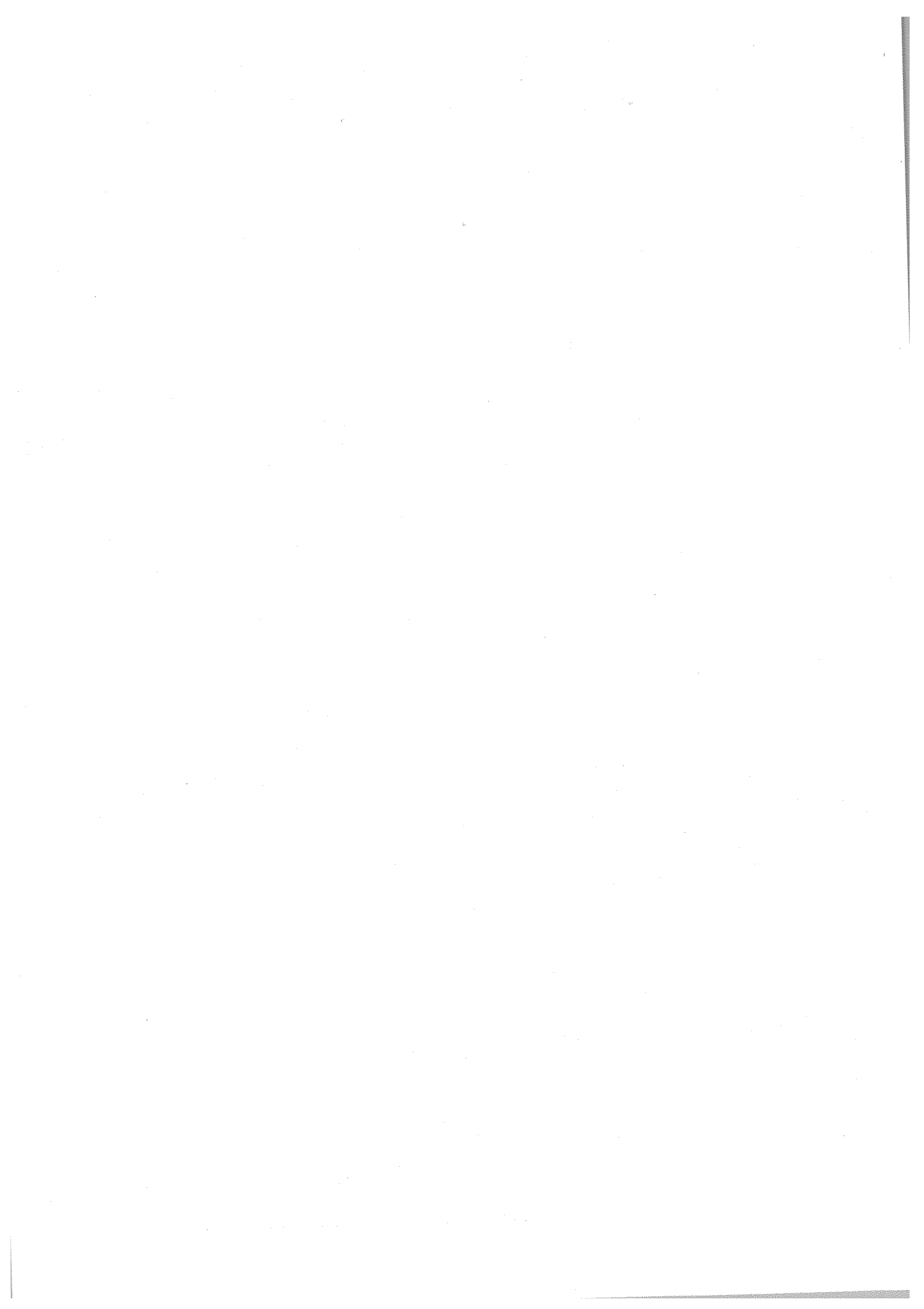

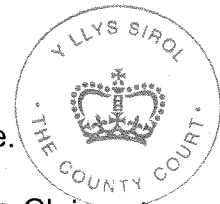

ORDER



By His Honour Judge Seys Llewellyn QC of the court's own initiative.

Upon the court having adjudicated in action 7CF07345 between the Claimant and the Defendant, upon the applications respectively by the Claimant dated 25 August 2016 to amend his Particulars of Claim and by the Defendant dated 23 September 2016 to strike out the Particulars of Claim or parts thereof, that a number of the claims in action 7CF07345 shall be struck out;

And upon the court having adjudicated that the claims still subsisting in action 7CF07345 after such striking out should be allocated a new action number for the claims so subsisting and shall be tried only after action 1CF03361;

And upon the court being aware that Mr Kirk has stated his wish that action 1CF03361 shall be tried by a judge and jury and/or in a court outside Wales;

IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. The stay upon action 1CF03361 shall be lifted.
2. The action shall be listed for mention on or after 30 January 2017 (or such other date whether earlier or later as the incoming Designated Civil Judge for Wales His Honour Judge Harrison shall direct) in order to consider (i) timetable and/or (ii) case management directions to bring the action to trial and/or (iii) venue and/or (iv) mode of trial, not by telephone, time estimate half a day.
3. The Claimant shall, in the event that he wishes to make submissions on case management directions and/or venue and/or mode of trial, by 2pm on 23 January 2017 file at the court a Position Statement and, (if he wishes to rely upon any witness statement), by the same date and time such a witness statement and shall serve a copy of the same upon the solicitors for the Defendant.

4. The Defendant shall in the event that he wishes to make submissions on case management directions and/or venue and/or mode of trial, by 2pm on 23 January 2017 file at the court and serve on the Claimant via the court a witness statement deposing to any factual matters on which he seeks to rely and by the same date and time a skeleton argument supported by copies of any case law or authority or authorities on which he seeks to rely.
5. This Order having been made at the court's own initiative any party affected by this Order may apply to have the same set aside varied or stayed provided that he does so in writing to the court within 7 days of this Order having been served upon him pursuant to Civil Procedure Rules CPR 3.3 (5) and (6).
