

Dear Ms Zammitt

Re: Maurice J KIRK (A7306AT)

I understand that you are obliged to rely on evidence supplied by the police. In this incidence you may not be aware that in 2009 Maurice was in the midst of suing the South Wales Police for harassment. As a caring veterinary surgeon he was always on call for sick animals. The Police continually stopped him, pretended they did not know him and caused a huge time-wasting effort on all parts. I believe Maurice went to the Magistrates Court over 130 times in a few years but was found not guilty in over 85% of these cases. Do not bother looking for the Police files as they were 'lost' between London and Cardiff in the early 21st century. Like the chaps who were in prison for murder and then released the papers may miraculously appear.

I attach to this letter psychiatric reports which counter the report written by Dr. Mel Tegwyn Williams in October 2009 in collusion with Dr Rodger Wood. Neither were neurologists but claimed a tumour or cancer in Maurice's brain. Of course he received no further assessment or treatment but this was presented to the pre-hearing before he was in the room. (2nd Dec 19)

It was only when the Dorset Probation Service received the 2009 Tegwyn Williams psychiatric report that the truth was out as to why Maurice has been dealt a deceitful punishment. The December 2018 OASys report confirmed the horror of falsified convictions. After 10 years it is about time the truth was out.

There are no convictions of Firearms Offences,

Child Abuse (he stopped a 17 year-old breaking into his flat)

Narcotics

Racial Abuse (he was involved in trying to help a Nigerian family)

Use of weapon (as a vet he needed a dehorning garotte style wire)

Harassment (the person in question has been proved a liar and dismissed his job)

I understand that 'the powers that be' instigated a label for Maurice in July 2009. Although never officially told (illegal) he discovered he was a MAPPA category 3 ie the most dangerous. The Police did not want the case against them in the Civil Court to ever be heard in the open. The doctor who wrote that report from

Caswell Clinic had been persuaded by the Police to write a damning report so that the trumped up charge of trading in firearms would not go to court as the 'offender' was mad enough to go to Ashworth for life. (Dr since dismissed) The jury quickly saw through the absurd court trial Jan 2010 and found the defendant NOT GUILTY.

I am a retired magistrate (not in UK courts) and found the case and the police behaviour through it quite unbelievable. The owner of the decommissioned 'Lewis gun' had had it for two years attached to the World War 1 plane (used in films) and he was not charged! The Police had even repainted the gun.

Maurice had sold the plane and gun. The plane cannot fly without the weight of the gun balancing the system. Maurice was a well known aerobatic pilot having won prizes in the past. He flew solo in his 1944 Piper Cub from UK to Australia and as a result was presented a prize by the then Australian Prime Minister. Of course he took risks but not at the expense of other people. There is a report that he landed on the lawn of President Bush's home in Texas. This was a total lie. He wanted to leave a message with the President to thank him for the coastguard service but not by landing on his lawn. He would have been shot before any questions were asked. He was reported to have flown under the Severn Bridge....more fabrication, no evidence. And so it goes on.

It is understood that there were/are members of the South Wales Police who hate him hence all this fabrication. Sadly none of these reports are altered when the truth is out. There is no way Maurice should be on hunger strike nor in prison when his convictions are wrong.

As a family we were brought up to protect those who were in a bad position due to the wrong actions of people in power. I am sure Maurice would not have stepped into Wales if he had known the situation of the boys in blue. There must be some folk in the uniform who dare not speak up for injustice.

An acceptable home was found for the Probation Service in Dorset but on false evidence when will Maurice be released. The lack of medical attention for his dislocated hip is the latest in poor medical help for a 74 year old. It seems that the South Wales Police want him dead.

Please be aware publicity will be used to expose these flagrant lies. I am aware you can do nothing but ignore the lies. Please do...
