Re: Maurice John KIRK (12.03.1945)

I wrote to you on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2019 and I am pleased that some of the convictions my brother was labelled with have been removed from his record as they had been fabricated. Sadly, he is now labelled as 'Violent' and that even the Chairman of the Parole Board whom he met on 15<sup>th</sup> October has been deemed a possible victim. As I was there throughout the hearing I cannot imagine where the evidence for this prediction comes from. At no point was Maurice Kirk violent to anyone. In fact I do not think he has any convictions of violence. Only the Offender Manager, Gavin Hall and Probation Officer Bradley Hughes were in the room with us at the Parole Board hearing.

Maurice has no evidence against him about violence to a or any female but in his licence it states that he would have to report any 'relationship with a female'. In the divorce courts a couple can feel under duress but there has been no evidence of violence that Maurice was aware of. I understand he is still very fond of Kirstie and greatly misses his daughter Genevieve. He even gave Kirstie his veterinary business and surgery in Llantwit Major long before any mention of a divorce. The female who was illegally removing an item from a flat he owned was grabbed by her arm and removed from the premises. It was only when the hood came off the body's face under a street light that he realised it was a female.

As I mentioned in my 29<sup>th</sup> July letter, my brother has a civil case against the South Wales Police about their harassment. Understandably they do not want this to be publicised as they would lose. This explains the deceit which has succeeded to keep my brother in prison on and off for ten years whilst trying to prove that a psychiatric report was incorrect made by a doctor under stress.

Maurice Kirk has signed a statement to allow the Caswell Clinic medical notes from July 2009 to October 2009 to be sent to me. I have not received them yet. HMP Parc also has the notes which according to the current Director of the Clinic show that no psychiatrist there at the time could state that Maurice Kirk had any mental illness apart from the then director.
