

1. Monday Maurice hoped to eat. On Sunday he started to eat and was promised his Omeraprozole to ease stomach pain. He has been prescribed this medicine for over 3 years. He has to take it a very short time before he eats to prevent pain. It did not materialise. Sunday night he writhed in agony all night.
 2. He called for healthcare Sunday lunchtime. A nurse arrived 2 1/2 hours later but gave no treatment. Sunday night he called for healthcare and hoped a doctor would be summoned. At last a qualified and caring nurse came at 9pm. She promised a doctor but no-one came nor any pain relief.
 3. Monday no food arrived and no medicine. He is bed bound and can only move if he is placed in a wheelchair (illfitting and inappropriate). He has to be pushed by someone to reach any destination (food hatch/medical hatch/showers etc) ILLEGAL
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1. 'The wing staff just look at me and laugh as if it is a big joke'
 2. Not allowed to photocopy any document either in library nor any other station.
 3. Documents addressed to Courts are routinely stopped or left in a pile in wing office unposted. Maurice represents himself at court.(on several past occasions has not been allowed to leave the prison) ILLEGAL
 4. 'I have had no supper delivered at least 8 times' ILLEGAL
